The German Major - Advanced Language, Literature, and Culture Emphasis requires a minimum of 27 upper-division credits listed under GERM and approved departments (a maximum of 6 credits may be taken as approved HIST, CLCS, and/or POLS courses). It also requires either WLC 2010 or 2020 and a WLC Practicum Signature Experience for a total of 33 credits. At least 15 credits have to be taken at the University of Utah. All courses must be passed with a grade of C or better. CR/NC may NOT be elected for these courses.

Students must complete the lower-division language sequence of 1010, 1020, 2010, and 2020, or the equivalent, before enrolling in GERM 3040 or 3060. For placement into classes, see https://languages.utah.edu. This major is designed for students who come to the U with at least some background in German. Students without previous German study or proficiency should instead take the German Major -- Society and Culture Emphasis. Students are encouraged to take WLC 2010 or 2020 before any other upper-division courses in the major and the WLC Practicum Signature Experience (except for Learning Abroad) after all or most of the other courses in the major have been finished.
