The Spanish Major requires a minimum of 30 upper-division credits listed under SPAN plus either WLC 2010 or 2020 and a WLC Practicum Signature Experience for a total of **36 credits**. CR/NC may NOT be elected for these courses.

Students must complete the lower-division language sequence of 1010, 1020, 2010, and 2020, or the equivalent, before enrolling in any upper-division language courses. Students are encouraged to take WLC 2010 or 2020 before any other upper-division courses in the major and the WLC Practicum Signature Experience (except for Learning Abroad) after all or most of the other courses in the major have been finished.
