# SPANISH MINOR

The Spanish Minor requires a minimum of **18-21 upper-division credits** listed under SPAN. At least 6 credits have to be taken at the University of Utah. All courses must be passed with a grade of C or better. CR/NC may NOT be elected for these courses.

Students must complete the lower-division language sequence of 1010, 1020, 2010, and 2020, or the equivalent, before enrolling in any upper-division language courses. Email wlc-advising@utah.edu if a required course is not available or a potentially appropriate available course is not listed as an elective.
