Declared Fall 2025 or Later

The German Minor requires a minimum of **18 upper-division credits** listed under GERM and approved departments. At least 6 credits have to be taken at the University of Utah. All courses must be passed with a grade of C or better. CR/NC may NOT be elected for these courses.

Students must complete lower-division language sequence of 1010, 1020, 2010, and 2020, or the equivalent, before enrolling in GERM 3040 or 3060.
