The World Languages and Cultures Major: Korean Emphasis requires a total of 52 credits. At least 15 credits must be taken at the University of Utah. All KOREA courses must be passed with a grade of B- or better to advance to the next level. CR/NC may NOT be elected for these courses.

Students who demonstrate higher proficiency through placement testing, AP credit, immersion experience, etc. may enroll in the course most appropriate for their level and bypass lower-division courses (1010, 1020, 2010, 2020). Students who bypass any lower-division course(s) will be required to purchase language credit (at a reduced rate) to reflect these credits on their student record.
