# **KOREAN & KOREAN STUDIES**

MINOR

Declared Fall 2025 or Later

The Korean & Korean Studies Minor requires a minimum of **15 upper-division credits** listed under KOREA and approved departments. At least 6 credits have to be taken at the University of Utah. Language courses must be passed with a grade of B- or higher to advance to the next level, and all other courses must be passed with a grade of C or higher. CR/NC may NOT be elected for any courses counting toward the 15 minor credits.

Students must complete the lower-division language sequence of 1010, 1020, 2010, and 2020, or the equivalent, before enrolling in any upper-division language courses. Email wlc-advising@utah.edu if a required course is not available or a potentially appropriate available course is not listed as an elective.
