MAJOR (BA)

Declared Fall 2025 or Later

The Spanish Teaching Major requires a minimum of **55 credits**. At least 15 credits have to be taken at the University of Utah. All courses must be passed with a grade of C or better. CR/NC may NOT be elected for these courses.

Students who demonstrate higher proficiency through placement testing, AP credit, immersion experience, etc. may enroll in the course most appropriate for their level and bypass lower-division courses (1010, 1020, 2010, 2020). Students who bypass any lower-division course(s) will be required to purchase language credit (at a reduced rate) to reflect these credits on their student record.
