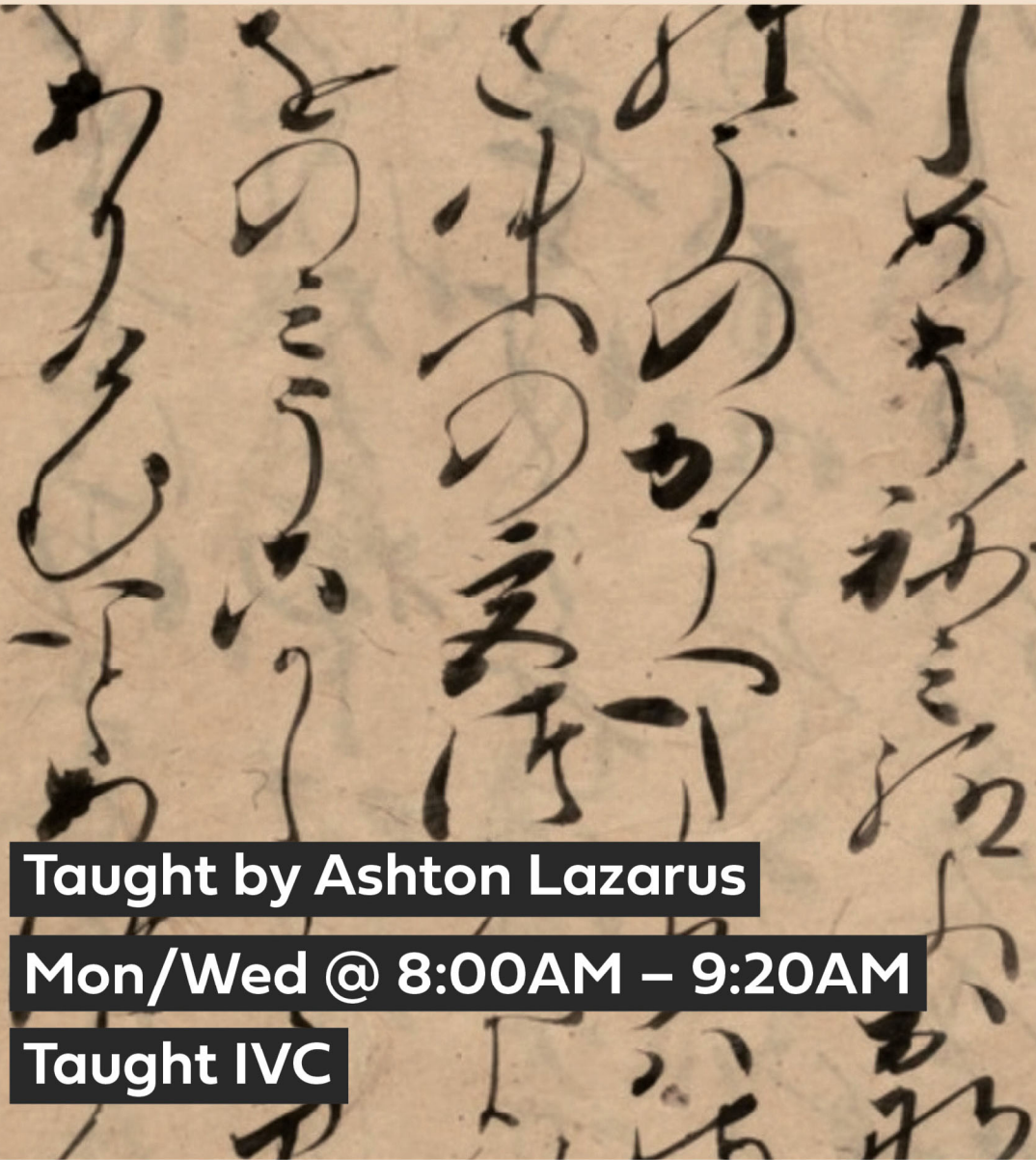

This course consists of a systematic introduction to classical Japanese (bungo), facilitated by homework, drills, tests, and reading and translating primary texts. It also covers the basics of reading literary Sinitic (kanbun), cursive script (kuzushiji), and non-standard kana (hentaigana), and will prepare students to navigate the diverse terrain of premodern Japanese texts. The course will be conducted in English for the most part, though the materials will be in Japanese.

Prerequisite: JAPAN 3040, 3060, or the equivalent.
