All courses must be passed with a grade of C or better. (B- or better required for advancement to next language level.)

**KOREA 3060** *Third-Year Korean I*

*Prerequisite: KOREA 2020 or intermediate background and proficiency in the Korean language*

**KOREA 3100** *Korean Culture through Literature and Film (taught in English)*

*\*KOREA 3070 may substitute KOREA 3060 or KOREA 4060 above, in which case the student must make up the 3 credits by taking another 3000+ level KOREA course taught in Korean.*
